Course aims Familiarizing the students with modern theoretical and practical aspects of financial markets and implementing theoretical, analytical and applied skills in the area of financial markets.			
Course outcome Students will be trained for the job of financial advisors, portfolio managers and other participants in the market, i.e. for creative problem-solving in modern markets and banks, broker-dealer companies, investment funds, insurance companies, etc.			
Course content <i>Theory classes</i> Financial market and its elements, national and international financial market. Financial centres. Money market, capital market, foreign market. Securities – types and kinds of securities. Capital market – institutions and instruments, shares, bonds, stock exchange. Money market – its role and mechanism, its institutions, short-term securities. Foreign exchange market – foreign currencies, and exchange rate, interdependence between foreign exchange market, capital market and money market. The market of financial derivatives. Private and Institutional investors. <i>Practice classes</i> Practicing on examples of the functioning of financial markets, project presentation, seminar papers and drafts, case studies.
