The outcome of the subject After the overcoming the materials about national environmental legislations, students will be able to understand the basic principles of regulation in the environmental field with legal instruments, to get the critically point of view and be prepare to analytically make planes, take implementation and control all aspects of environmental management in business practice.			
Syllabus <i>Theoretical study</i> - The basic principles underlying the national legislation in the field of environment; system of legal norms in the field of environment (planning and building, mining, geological exploration, water, soil, forests, flora and fauna, national parks, fishing, hunting, waste management, production and circulation of toxins, trade and transport of explosive and hazardous materials, radiation protection and nuclear safety, etc.); evaluation of compliance of laws with EU legislation; evaluation of the implementation of the law. Special emphasis will be on practical examples and experiences of law enforcement. <i>Practical classes</i> - Exercises with practical examples of national environmental legislation –presentation of seminar papers and case studies.
