Course aims Aim of the course is to provide basic knowledge about economic integration, before and after the EU establishment, which has undergone important transformations during the last 15 years.			
Course outcome Students will be able to apply critical thinking and understanding of the reasons and motives for Europeans integrations, historical reasons for integration, costs and benefits, basic Union's policies and all other important issues in this domain.			
Course content <i>Theory classes</i> Introduction to the history of all economic integration forms before the EU, gradual institutional development aimed at economic development, the importance and role of major EU summits which had led to the EU as exists today, elements of the Treaties of Rome, Luxembourg compromise and the Hague Convention, tasks and roles of the institutions, the chronology of the EU relations with the candidates from the Central and Eastern Europe, their experience, accession to the EU. <i>Practice classes</i> Examples for every part of the theoretical lectures.
