#### Course outcome

Introducing students to the process of assessing security challenges and risks in functioning of the security system, through participation in the work of various institutions in the state, private and business organizations and institutions: from the planning process to the analysis; to look at problems of organization life and the work of certain organizations through a direct insight into organizational processes, the complexity and comprehensiveness of the functioning of the security system and other measures for the prevention of various negative events.

# **Course outcome**

Understanding the complexity of the operations of security managers and understanding the level of necessary knowledge and skills in all areas of life and work of institutions, administrative bodies, production and other organizations.

# **Course content**

### Theory classes

Introduction with the system of functioning. Documentation for planning, organizing and implementing measures of protection and rescue in extraordinary situations as well as the life and work of the organization or institution. Practically with crisis plans and other plans in case of need for evacuation and rescue or elementary and other disasters. Getting acquainted with the on-call system and participating in on-call duty in fire fighting units in which professional practice is conducted. Getting acquainted with the organization and way of working of specific institutions, manufacturing and other organizations. Realization of other activities within organization or institution.

### Practice classes

Consideration of management processes primarily related to the protection of property and persons, obligations related to the civil protection and taking measures from preventing extraordinary events. Preparation of documentation for planning, organizing and realization of fire-fighting training. Material-financial operations in a unit. Introduction with the on-call system and participating in on-call duty at the institution where the professional practice is carried out.

### **Teaching methods**

The professional practice is realized in one of the organizations - associates with the University and with whom the contracts on the professional practice of students have been concluded.
