Course aims

Acquiring knowledge on emergency management, the competencies of the administrative bodies, the participation of the police and the Serbian Army in protection and rescue, the rights and duties of citizens, companies and civil protection activities on protection and rescue and the elimination of the consequences of natural disasters.

Course outcome

Knowledge about the system of protection and rescue, emergency situations caused by various elementary and other disasters, the competencies of certain state bodies and local self-government bodies, companies and civil society, the police and the Serbian Armed Forces and the functioning of civil protection as well as the aspects of strengthening the security of all segments of the society.

Course content

Theory classes - Etiology of endangerment; Protection and rescue system; Entities of the protection and rescue system; Competencies of state bodies; Autonomy of the Autonomous Province and local self-government units; Rights and obligations of companies and other legal entities; Rights and duties of citizens; Emergency Situations; Civil protection; Planning and programming of protection and rescue systems.

Practice classes - Analysis of concrete organizational solutions of modern systems of protection, rescue and emergency management. Enabling the development of individual planning documents that form the country's defense plan; visits to the Emergency Situations Directorate of Serbia, the Republic and City Information Center.
