The Economy Excellence Alliance for Stimulating Innovative and Inclusive Green Transition (BEAMING) is an innovative project dedicated to advancing excellence and promoting innovation within the field of bioeconomy. This initiative seeks to address the need to enhance the competitiveness and vitality of higher education institutions (HEIs) in Europe, with a particular focus on leading countries in Eastern European like Member States, and the Western Balkans.

To its end, the BEAMING project will bring together HEIs from diverse regions, promoting the transfer of knowledge and technology, and fostering a culture of collaboration by focusing on various key objectives: strengthening the skills and capacities of university researchers in bioeconomy research; fostering institutional reform; providing cross-disciplinary collaboration; enhancing technology transfer; and encouraging an inclusive institutional culture.

The initiative will follow a methodology based on the Quadruple Helix innovation ecosystem approach, which involves collaboration between HEIs, industry, government, and civil society. This approach will enhance the capacity for innovation and the practical application of research results, as well as engage the general public in processes, facilitating changes in consumer behavior and environmental awareness.
